It has come to our attention that there have been instances of members using both honorary and honorific titles in ways that may not align with our club's standards and practices. We value the respect and integrity that these titles represent and it is essential that members exercise care and diligence in using them in any capacity, especially as members of the Club.

We kindly remind all members who have been bestowed with such titles to respect the dignity of the titles and they should only be used by members who have officially earned them, either through professional qualifications or recognised status by the respective Authorities, including the State Rulers, Governors of Penang, Melaka, Sarawak & Sabah and his Majesty, the King of Malaysia. MIsuse of these titles can lead to confusion and may undermine the respect and dignity associated with them.

To maintain the dignity of our Club and the titles one holds, we ask that all members adhere to the following guidelines:

- 1. **Verify credentials**: It is the responsibility of each member to ensure that you have the appropriate credentials and supporting documents before using any of these titles. The Club is duty bound to inspect representations and documentations to substantiate these titles.
- 2. **Respect other members**: We ask that members be mindful of how these titles are used in conversations and correspondences. Misuse and misrepresentations can lead to misunderstandings amongst members.
- 3. **Promote integrity**: Members are encouraged by their contract with the Club's constitution to uphold the integrity of the Club by respecting each other's qualifications and Titles.

We appreciate your cooperation in this matter and look forward to maintaining a respectful and honorable environment for all members.
